FESTIVAL INFO



THE 12TH EDITION OF LIBF RETURNS TO KIRKSTALL ABBEY, AND WE'VE TAKEN OVER THE ENTIRE VENUE, INCLUDING THE CHURCH, COURTYARD AND CLOISTER.

The handy map on the centre pages in this guide will help you find your way around - remember each session last for five hours (except the Thursday session which lasts for 6 hours), so there's plenty of time to explore everything the festival has to offer.

Last orders are called 30 mins before the end of each session. The breweries will stop taking orders 15 mins before the session end time.

All the beers and ciders available at this year's festival are listed alphabetically by brewery on the following pages. There's also info on the food stalls and live music/DJ sets throughout the festival.

There will also be plenty of bins on site. Please help us to keep the site clean by disposing of your own rubbish.

'Pass outs' will not be available this year. If you choose to leave before your session ends you will not be re-admitted.

A FEW THINGS TO BE AWARE OF:

Due to the nature of the site, the ground in some areas is quite uneven and there are some small steps - so make sure you watch your step.

Ramps will be in place across the site to ensure full accessibility.

Kirkstall Abbey is also a protected monument so please don't climb on any part of the ruins. Anyone breaking this golden rule will be ejected from the festival site.

There is **no** smoking or vaping on site.

FESTIVAL PAYMENT

The festival will use a contactless payment system, and all the breweries and food stalls will be able to accept card payments. **No cash payments will be accepted.**

Tokens from previous festivals, that you may still have in your possession, will no longer be accepted as payment.



Wayward started back in 2017 as a small shop and bar up in Chapel Allerton. The focus was on natural wine from small European producers in a casual setting that made them easily available in Leeds for the first time.

The idea was that the wine would always come from small, low-yield vineyards farmed without chemicals and the wines would be made simply from the grapes – nothing added or taken away.

Seven years later and the shop is going strong, now with the addition of Wayward Imports, an arm of the business that works directly with over 20 growers across France, Italy and Spain. Working closely with restaurants and bars in Leeds and beyond. Wayward now distribute these wines to like-minded businesses around the country. You can try a selection of them at the Bundobust Tipi this weekend.
